

WILDHAWK PLAYERS ASSOCIATION TOURNAMENT SET UP

Policy:

The Wildhawk Players Association, Tournament Committee will create flights for each tournament determined by the type of tournament and quantity of players. The Goal of the WPA is to have a range of 8 to 12 players per flight.

Procedure:

Procedures will vary depending on the type of tournament:

All NCGA events are net scoring and the men will play from the blue tees and the women from the green tees. All NCGA flight parameters as stated in NCGA Qualification Guidelines will be used.

Individual Stroke Play Tournaments will be flighted. The lowest handicapped flight (1st flight) will play from the gold tees and play as “gross” and “net” to include all players with a WPA Tournament Course Handicap of 6 or lower. A minimum of 4 players are needed to make this flight. All other flights will be played “net” and the balance of players will be divided as equally as possible using WPA Tournament Course Handicaps. If necessary, individual WPA Tournament Indexes will be used to determine flights’ divisional points.

Scramble and Fun Tournaments will be flighted by combining the participant’s handicaps and weighing the total by 70% of the lowest handicap / 30% of the highest handicap player in 2 player tournaments. In 4 player tournament the percentages would be 70/15/10/5. Flight divisions will be determined by the quantity of participants.

Projected payouts to winners will be dollars in Pro Shop credit: 1st place = \$100, 2nd place = \$75, 3rd place = \$50. The First flight will be 1st place gross = \$100 (in lieu of a 3rd place payout), then 1st place net of the remaining players = \$100. (The First Flight may not pay 2nd place if the participant number is lower than the other flights.) 1st place in all flights may increase to \$125 when there are enough monies available before making another flight. These amounts may need to be reduced in multiple player tournaments.
