

## **WILDHAWK PLAYERS ASSOCIATION TOURNAMENT SET UP**

### ***Policy:***

The Wildhawk Players Association, Tournament Committee will create flights for each tournament determined by the type of tournament and quantity of players. The Goal of the WPA is to have a range of 8 to 12 players per flight.

### ***Procedure:***

Procedures will vary depending on the type of tournament:

All NCGA events are net scoring and the men will play from the blue tees and the women from the green tees. All NCGA flight parameters as stated in qualification guidelines will be used.

Individual Stroke Play Tournaments will be flighted and played net score. The lowest handicapped flight (1<sup>st</sup> flight) will play from the gold tees to include all players with a WPA Tournament Course Handicap of 6 or lower. A minimum of 4 players are needed to have this flight play the gold tees. The balance of players will be divided as equally as possible using WPA Tournament Course Handicaps or NCGA Handicap whichever is lower and played from the blue tees. If necessary, individual WPA Tournament Indexes or NCGA Indexes will be used to determine flights' divisional points. The 4th flight men will play from the white tees. Women will play from the green tees.

Scramble and Fun Tournaments will be flighted by combining the participant's handicaps and weighing the total by 70% of the lowest handicap / 30% of the highest handicap player in 2 player tournaments. In 4 player tournaments the percentages would be 70/15/10/5. Flight divisions will be determined by the quantity of participants. Players in the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3rd flights, (or groups), will play from the blue tees and players in the 4<sup>th</sup> flights, (or groups), will play from the white tees. Women will play from the green tees.

Projected payouts to winners will be dollars in Pro Shop credit. The number of players will determine the number and amount of prizes. All flight payouts will be equal. Example: 1<sup>st</sup> place = \$100, 2<sup>nd</sup> place = \$75, 3<sup>rd</sup> place = \$50. These amounts will be reduced in multiple player tournaments.
