

WILDHAWK PLAYERS ASSOCIATION TOURNAMENT HANDICAP / INDEX

All WPA tournaments will be handicapped by using the players WPA Tournament Handicap / Index. The WPA Tournament Handicap/Index will be calculated by capturing your WPA Tournament scores posted within the last 24 calendar months. Of those scores captured we will use the most recent 12 scores. Of those 12 scores we will use the lowest 6 scores to establish your WPA handicap (lowest 50% of the captured qualifying scores).

If you do not have 12 qualifying scores in the last 24 months we will use the qualifying scores you do have and will use the lowest 50% of those scores to establish your WPA handicap.

Example: If you only had 8 qualifying scores in the last 24 months, we will capture those 8 scores and then use the lowest 4 of those scores to establish your WPA handicap.

Example: If you had nine qualifying scores in the last 24 months, we will capture the lowest 4 qualifying scores (50% of the qualifying scores or less, nearest to 50%) to establish your WPA handicap.

If 1 or less eligible scores are available, then 80% of their current NCGA index will be used.

Players who have not established a handicap index, the handicap will not be established until the end of the round. At the scoring table the scoring committee determines the differential of the participant's score from par (i.e.: Score 82. Par 72. Differential 10). The participant's handicap will be 80% of the differential rounded down to the nearest whole number. In the example above, the handicap would be 8 ($80\% \times 10 = 8$).

If the player's current NCGA Index at the time the tournament registration is closed is lower than his/her WPA Index then the NCGA Index will be used.
